The Croatian Association for Logotherapy - Logos is listed in the directory of accredited members of the VFI Vienna for conducting education in logotherapy counselling and psychotherapy, for public information and dissemination of logotherapy and existential analysis, for therapy and counselling according to Viktor Frankl's logotherapy, as well as for research in the

The LOGOS education program is exemplary as it is particularly thorough, comprising four years. The program includes four theoretical semesters on the theoretical foundations and settings of logotherapy and existential analysis (800 teaching hours) with practical experience (200 hours), as well as 350 hours of work with clients under constant supervision (150 hours), furthermore personal experience in workshops and work on a personal guided autobiography (250 hours in total). It

consists of 1,750 hours of education in total and meets the highest standards in the field.
